

Welcome to the Tennessee Online Voter Registration System

You must have a Tennessee driver's license or Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security ID in order to submit this application online. If you do not have a Tennessee driver's license or Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security ID, you will be able to print the voter registration form and submit by mail.

Name or Address Change within Smith County

Are you a registered voter in Smith County and need to update your name or address from one address located in Smith County to another address in Smith County? You will need to submit a request at least 5 days before any upcoming election. If early voting has begun, an address or name change can be done when you come to vote at an early voting location.

If a registered voter waits until Election Day to update their information, the voter must complete an affidavit before being allowed to vote. The voter will be required to vote at the correct polling location based on their new address.

**NOTE: These rules apply even if you have been registered and voted in another county in Tennessee.

Did you move to a different county?

If you move to a different county, it is not considered an address change. Your registration does not transfer to other counties in Tennessee. A voter must register in their new county by submitting a voter registration application at least 30 days before an election. The voter may register online, in person at the Election Office, or mail the application to the election office in their county. You may register online or complete and print an application to mail by clicking the link at the bottom of the page. If the voter submits the application by-mail, the voter must vote in person at the first election.

Remember registrations do not transfer from county to county and if the above requirements are not met the voter will not be allowed to vote in that election.

New Registrations

TN requirements to vote:

- You must be a U.S. Citizen
- You must be a resident of Tennessee
- You must be at least 18 years old on/or before the next election
- If you have been convicted of a felony, your eligibility to register and vote depends upon the crime you were convicted of and the date of your conviction. If your conviction made you ineligible, you may regain your eligibility if your conviction has been expunged or if you have had your voting rights restored, unless you were convicted of a crime that rendered you permanently ineligible to vote. Instructions:

Fill in all the required fields on the application. An online application for a new voter registration must be submitted at least thirty (30) days before the next election.

Or

A printed voter registration application for a new voter must be postmarked or hand delivered to the county election commission office at least thirty (30) days before the next election.
